Where will the Eid Jamat take place?

The Eid Jamat will take place at Wimbledon Park Athletics track. There will be no Jamats at the Masjid.

How can I travel to the Athletics track?

There are 3 entrances for vehicles and visitors:

1. Revelstoke Road on the east
2. Wimbledon Park Road in the northwest (Southfields entrance)
3. Home Park Road pedestrian entrance only

The shortest walks will be from the Revelstoke Road and Wimbledon Park Road entrances

How do I walk to the venue after entering the park?

There are two entrances to the Athletics track. The following are some walking guidelines to access the two entrances of the Athletics track, depending on how you enter the park.

- Revelstoke Road entrance - walk towards the corner of the lake using the footpath or across the grass. The entrance is located near the end of the lake. Approximate 5 minutes average paced walking.
- Home Park Road entrance – the closest entrance to the Athletics track is the same as above. It should take 5-10 minutes average pace walking.
- Wimbledon Park Road entrance – continue straight along the boundary of the park for an approximate 5 minutes average pace walking.

What time should I arrive?

Arrival will be from 8:45am. Please do avoid arriving too early as the entrances will be closed prior to 8:45am. Please also give yourself sufficient time to walk through the park to the athletics stadium.

What is the format of the day?

- 8:45am – Arrival
- 9am – English talk
- 9:30am – Eid prayer followed by Khutbah
- 11am – Venue closed.

Can ladies and children attend?

Yes, brothers, sisters, and children can attend InshaAllah.

Where is the ladies prayer section?

The prayer will take place on the grass at the centre of the track. The rear of the grass area will be allocated for female prayers.

What can I do after the Eid Jamat?

There will be light refreshments available to purchase after the Eid Jamat. The Athletics ground will be closed to Wimbledon Masjid shortly after 11am but you can choose to spend time in the park at your own leisure.

What do I need to bring to the Eid Jamat?

Bring your own prayer mats and your own chair/stool if you require this for prayers. **Please also come with wudhu.**
