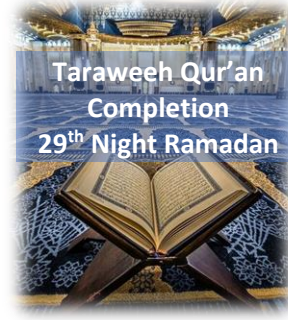
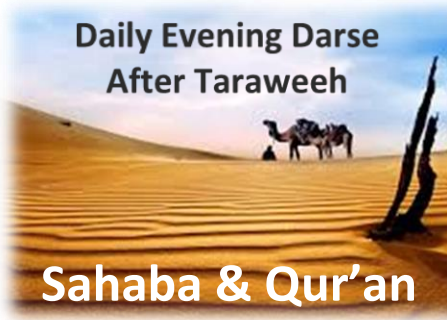

Give Your Sadaqatul Fitr Early

How much to pay?
£5 is due on every member of a household, including any children or elderly people.

When to pay?
Fitrana, must be paid during Ramadan, before the Eid prayers at the very latest. This is a very specific time frame that all Muslims must abide to.

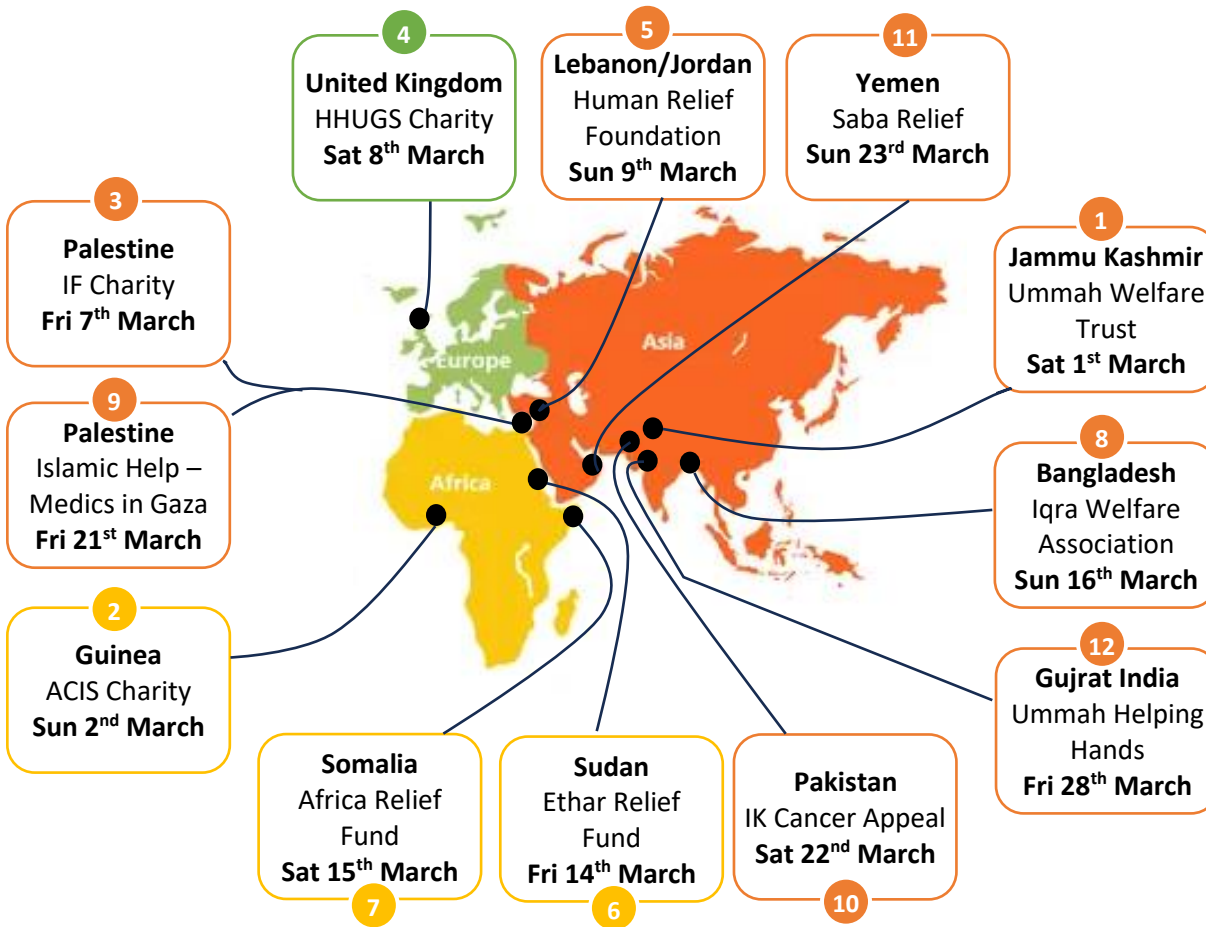
Where will it go?
The aim is to get the money to the needy by Eid. Wimbledon Masjid will distribute via our charity partners in three batches:

1. Middle of Ramadan
2. End of Ramadan
3. Up until the Eid prayers.

- How to pay?**
1. Masjid – by cash in the labelled boxes
 2. Masjid – by card using donation kiosks
 3. Online - through our website
